Financial Highlights

Strengthening My Recovery has been well funded since our inception. From the start, we've been able to robustly support the World Service Organization and their extensive service structure. We maintain a prudent reserve of \$300.00. Our only financial obligation at present is the cost of our Zoom account, roughly \$150.00, which is due next July. We are exploring the possibility of expanding the size of our Zoom Room, if only to determine how many members may be unable to get into the meeting each day.
