Here are some highlights that stood out this month:

- This is a very busy time of year as everyone is preparing for the virtual ABC/AWC in May
- At the ABC this year, they will be eliminating Robert's Rules of Order to reflect our global membership and in recognition of delegates who may not be familiar with Robert's Rules.
- There has been unprecedented growth in global membership and the need for publications. There is also a significant shortfall in revenues creating an urgent need to increase the price of the BRB from \$15 to \$21

There is an ongoing discussion with the legal team about whether ACA is required to provide retirement plans for their employees in California.

#### **Can of Worms Department**
