History

Created when we were fewer than 100 members

Created in MailChimp in a free account.

When we reached our maximum, we upgraded our MailChimp

The list has been culled twice. It was not a satisfactory outcome either time. This was done by sending three emails asking whether the recipient wanted to remain on the list. If none of those emails were opened, the name was removed.

Current status

• Uses MailChimp costs about \$750/year. The cost includes our mailing list, which is private and not causing a problem.

How the contact list is/was created

- A subset of our mailing list is exported to Excel
- Columns of unneeded information are removed. Remaining information is formatted in a readable format
- The admin searches for anyone who does not want to be contacted by phone but who has entered a phone number and removes the phone numbers by hand
- The list is alphabetized by first name
- A PDF is created and both the Excel file and PDF are uploaded to the web site.
